Our recital will be on Saturday, June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2008. The rehearsal is scheduled for after school, Friday, June 13<sup>th</sup>. Picture days are Friday and Saturday, May 9 & 10. You will receive a schedule as to when you need to be present for pictures and rehearsal. Please see Payment Information for costume prices.

## **Payment Information**

To register, the first family member is \$25.00, and each additional member is \$10.00. Tuition may be paid in 5 installments due on Sept. 15, Nov. 15, Jan. 15, Mar. 15 and May 15. A 5% discount will be given for tuition payment of the entire year made by Sept. 15<sup>th</sup>. Unfortunately, payment made after the 20<sup>th</sup> will be considered late and will incur a 10% or \$10.00 late fee, whichever is greater. Payment may be made by check or credit card, sent in by mail, dropped off at the desk, or called in. A recital costume deposit of \$50.00 will be due on the Nov. 15<sup>th</sup> invoice for each class. Balance will be due on Feb. 15<sup>th</sup>. Costumes will not exceed \$85.00 per class. Returned check fee is \$25.00.

## **Refund Policy**

Registration is a commitment for the entire season. Once we register a spot for your child, we are committed to a teacher, to hold a spot for your dancer, and to conduct the class. We do understand that families and children have unexpected events occurring in their lives. In the event that your child cannot continue with the program, our policy is as follows: Withdrawal from class prior to Nov. 1 will forfeit the first tuition payment and registration payment, regardless of how many classes were attended. Withdrawal should be done in writing and accepted at the desk. Withdrawal after Nov. 1 will forfeit a pro-rated amount to be determined, and will also forfeit any recital deposits/payments made. All discounts/referral bonuses will be forfeited with early withdrawal.

## **Referral Fees & Scholarships**

A \$50-100.00 referral bonus will be rebated back to you after the end of the year for each family who has registered for the year with us, completed the year, and paid in full (amount determined by # of classes). FPD does offer some scholarship monies. Please talk to the director about the details.
